

FBCC Facility Usage Guidelines - 2016

Haggai 1:8 "Build my house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored," says the Lord.

Everyone has the responsibility to take care of God's house, and stop anyone from misuse or abuse of the church property.

ROOM CLEANLINESS:

- Eat and drink inside a room. No food is allowed on hallways, lobbies or public areas.
- Set up tables/chairs for children to sit down to eat/drink & teach them to clean up everything before leaving.
- Drain unwanted pure liquid in the sinks. Dispose grease in sealed bags or containers.
- Dispose all trash in trash cans.
- Use extra trash bags after a trash can is full. Tie up all extra trash bags before leaving.
- Clean tabletops and other surfaces of litter, food crumbs, beverage cans, cups, and spills.
- Clean whiteboards or chalkboard after use. Use cork board properly without damage or writing on it.
- Return tables, chairs, and any A/V equipment to their original positions.
- NO hot pot or cooking of any kind inside the church buildings except approved cooking in the kitchens.
- Avoid drinks, condiments or any sauce that may cause tough food stain on carpet areas.

SAFETY POLICIES:

- A. Children & Youths
- All children should be under <u>adult supervision</u> after AWANA, during church lunch & any program.
- No running inside buildings.
- No climbing on tables, chairs, windows, staircase, railings, countertop, structures, or any indoor and outdoor areas that may pose danger to anyone. Teach them to respect church signs on unrestricted area.
- Parents are responsible & liable for any mess or damage incurred by your children.

B. Activities

- Sport activities are limited to designated areas. (e.g. Gym, Multi-purpose rooms, Youth Center etc.) NO playing ball of any kind in the church lobbies or in any classrooms.
- NO sport equipment of any kind that has wheels is allowed inside the church buildings

SPILLS AND STAINS:

1. Soda Stain

- Get rid of much liquid as possible, right away.
- Pat the soda stain with a wet cloth or paper towel, press gently into the affected area and wait 15 minutes.
- Use a clean white cloth or paper towel to pat the stain dry.
- Avoid scrubbing, as this may cause the soda to soak into the carpet even more.

2. Food Stain

- Remove any solid food particles you're able to reach right away.
- Use dampen paper towel to dab at the stain until all the food particles within the carpet have been cleaned.
- Do not rub the stain, as this will only cause it to spread around.
- **Check with church office** if you need cleaning supplies and tools.
- **Report to church office** for any damage or major spill that needs thorough cleaning.
